


## Celebrating Francisco Morazan





## FUN in the SUN










One weekend, the boys had a blast going to a water park and swimming, diving, sliding and splashing around! What fun!







### 2016 Science Fair




This year, each boy researched and performed his own experiment and then presented to a group of students and judges. What a blessing!
