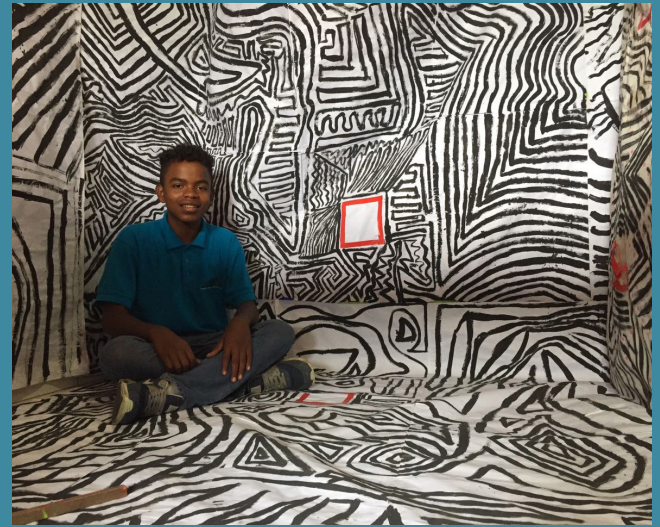
Independence Day

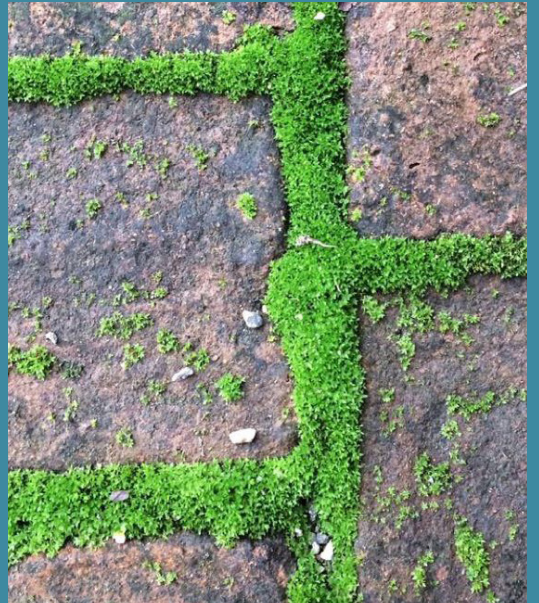
Art Class Wonders
