- Organizational skills, time management skills
- Experience in childcare—kids and teens (who have experienced trauma and great pain early in life)
- Can be trusted to represent the Micah Project within and outside the workspace; spiritually mature

- Covering shifts at the Micah house—in charge of the home with a team or partner, completing various tasks, caring for the boys, facilitating safety and security
- One potential responsibility would be organizing and hosting groups from the United States
